### LUXURY CATAMARAN

The *Kaimaka* or "eyes of the sea" in Hawaiian is our new custom-built catamaran. Like the *Noa Noa* "Feeling Free", which is considered the island of Hawaii's most precious gem, the *Kaimaka* is a custom-built, 50-foot catamaran that will accommodate up to 49 passengers. By day the catamarans provide breathtaking views of the Kohala Coast during morning snorkel sails and whale watching expeditions during migration season. In the evening, the *Noa Noa* and *Kaimaka* offer romantic sunset and starlight sails.

### CUSTOM DESIGNED DIVE BOAT

The *Lani Kai* is Red Sail Sports 38-foot Delta dive boat, designed in the United States for operation in the Pacific. The boat, which comfortably accommodates up to 18, was designed with a diver's needs and comfort in mind. It is equipped with a spacious dive platform, restroom facilities, fresh water showers and fresh water rinse buckets. Cold beverages, seasonal fruit, snacks and fresh towels are provided with every dive.

## DIVE THE BIG ISLAND

Hawaii is the most geographically isolated place on Earth — 2,000 miles from the nearest major land mass. An amazing 40 percent of Hawaii's marine animals are found nowhere else in the world. Among the 500 plus native underwater life: giant sea turtles, moray eels, eagle rays, raccoon butterfly fish, the Hawaiian turkeyfish and several species of scorpion and trigger fish.

The Big Island's Kohala Coast offers some of the best diving of the Hawaiian Islands. The water here is clear year-round often exceeding 100-foot visibility, with temperatures ranging from 72 degrees in the winter to 80 degrees in the summer. The Big Island is still growing, thanks to the world's most active volcano, Kilauea on the flank of Mauna Loa. As a result, Kohala is dominated by intricate lava flows, tunnels and crevices. The Coast offers steep drop-offs close to shore, 150-foot lava tubes and the worlds largest tiger cowries. Red Sail Sports offers both afternoon and morning boat dives to more than a dozen hand-picked dive sites along the Kohala Coast.

## PANILOLO CYCLE ADVENTURE

The Red Sail Sports adventure experts begin the ride with a beautiful drive northward along the coastline. The drive then turns "mauka" (towards the mountains) through green pastures and cattle ranches that offer breath-taking views of the ocean, the Kohala Mountains, Mauna Kea, and Mauna Loa. Upon reaching Paniolo country, the 21-speed mountain bikes and helmets are unloaded and the adventure resumes on bicycle. With mild rolling hills, the ride is well-suited for beginners and the avid cyclist. The 12 mile journey begins in the old sugar cane town of Honoka'a and winds through this quaint little town known for its historical country charm and antique shops. The ride continues along the tree-lined road of Kukuihaele with fantastic views of the Hamakua Coast. The final destination is Waipio Valley Lookout where guests enjoy a resort prepared picnic lunch and breathtaking views of famous Waipio Valley. After lunch, the Red Sail Sports team is ready to whisk the adventurers back to the hotel to continue their Hawaiian-style vacation.
